

indsor-based Casilco Corp., run by husband and wife Carlo and Rosa Corsini, has purchased two quality buildings along Walkerville's humming business strip.

The company, which owns a large catalogue of diverse properties across Canada and in the U.S. and yet has maintained local roots, picked up the **Envy Boutique** and **Refine Fitness Studio** buildings for \$2.7 million. The addresses are 1645 and 1623 Wyandotte Street East.

The Envy Boutique store is on the first of three stories, topped by **Bounce** Hair Boutique on the second floor and long-time occupant Archon Architects on the third. Next door is the Refine Fitness building.

The seller was a group including Daniel Soleski, one-time partner in Archon. The Corsini's are big Walkerville boosters and already own property at 475 Devonshire Road.
